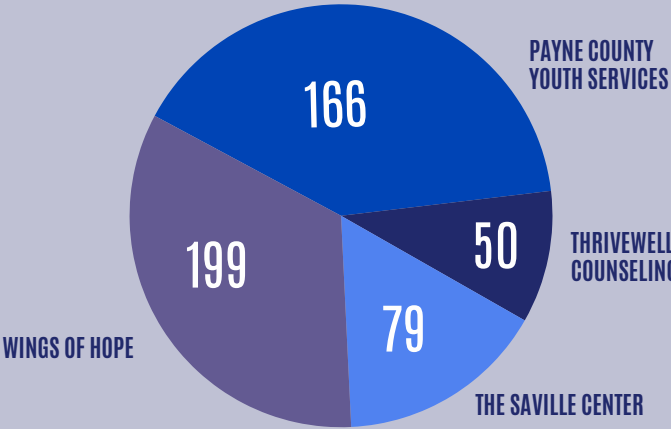
COMMUNITY RESILIENCY

494 Individuals received mental health counseling support.

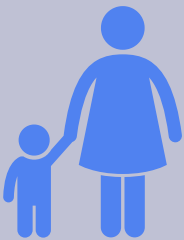


20,485 free books were delivered to Payne County children (aged 0-5).
