

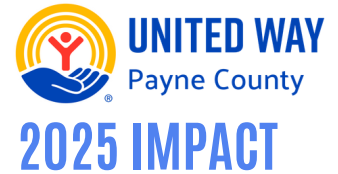
MOBILIZING PAYNE COUNTY TO ACTION SO ALL CAN THRIVE
